## Travel Directions

From Liverpool - M62- leave at J9, turn left following the signs north for A49 Newton. Proceed along Newton High Street; at mini roundabout (Oak Tree Public House) turn left into Crow Lane East. Proceed through two sets of traffic light. At the third traffic lights turn left into Cross Lane. Chapel Street is the second on the right, with Newton-le-Willows Methodist Church located on the corner with Cross Lane.

Via M6 - leave at J23 (Haydock Island, East Lancs Rd) and follow signs via A49(S) to Newton via Lodge Lane & Ashton Road. At the Oak Tree Public House mini roundabout turn right into Crow Lane East - then as above.

The church has a small car park but there is ample street parking and a public car park in nearby Fairclough Street (One Way)

The railway station, EARLESTOWN is a few minutes walk away, via Fairclough Street.
